TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - [1 Samuel 3:3B-10, 19](#): In the temple, young Samuel hears the Lord's voice thrice but confuses it for Eli. Eli recognizes the divine call and advises Samuel to respond, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." Samuel obeys, and from then on, he grows in God's presence, with his words carrying significance.

Responsorial Psalm - [Psalm 40](#): *R. Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.* With patient anticipation, I waited for the Lord. He inclined to my plea, gracing me with a new song of praise. I offer not sacrifices, but an open ear to obey. In the scroll, it's written—my joy is in fulfilling Your will, and Your law resides within my heart. I proclaim Your righteousness boldly, my lips unbridled in the assembly.

Second Reading - [1 Corinthians 6:13C-15A, 17-20](#): Remember, our bodies are meant for the Lord, a temple of the Holy Spirit. United with Christ, we must avoid immorality, as it dishonors both ourselves and God. We were bought at a cost, so let's honor Him in our bodies.

Gospel - [John 1:35-42](#): John the Baptist points out Jesus as the Lamb of God. Two of his disciples decide to follow Jesus, and he invites them to see where he stays. Andrew, one of the disciples, excitedly tells his brother Simon Peter that they've found the Messiah, and Jesus gives Peter a new name, Cephas (Peter).

AT THE
NAME OF
JESUS
EVERY KNEE

In this Gospel, John gives Jesus three titles: Lamb of God, Rabbi and Messiah. John the Baptist, shows great humility and purpose, when he continues to point his own disciples to Jesus. John is fulfilling his purpose.

Jesus *turns to face* and initiates a conversation with the two disciples. “What are you looking for?” These are the first words Jesus speaks in John’s Gospel. This shows us God’s heart. He does not leave us to search and search on our own, but He is there helping us all along the way. He is One who is always standing vigilant, waiting for us, wanting us to turn to Him.

Jesus doesn’t bother with any introductions, for He knows the disciples and that they know of Him. So Jesus gets to the point immediately, and asks them what they are looking for. This is an interesting question; one that we need to ask ourselves.

Personal reflection causes you to slow down, to take stock, and observe what motives might be revealed through your actions. Ask yourself: “What am I searching for?” “What do I want from Jesus”

What Andrew learned from spending time with Jesus that day, was enough to convince him of Jesus’ authority and identity. Andrew consistently brings people to meet Jesus throughout the gospel of John. Andrew is a great example of what we should be doing each day.
