What is the Promise of Divine Mercy Sunday?

On Divine Mercy Sunday Our Lord promised through St. Faustina, that He not only wants to forgive all of our sins, he wants to remove all of the punishment coming to us as a result of the damage our sin caused. This is a complete fresh start, it is the restoration of Baptismal Grace in the soul! Here is what we need to do to receive this amazing gift:

1

Go to confession

[Go as close to DMS as possible, but Lent will suffice. Just be in a state of grace, if you committed mortal sin go again before mass on DMS]



2

On Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion in a state of grace.



As you receive Holy Communion, do so with the intention of obtaining the promised grace. Be mindful and thankful.

The graces of My mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is — trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive (1578)

To add to this beautiful act, you can do items 3 and 4 as well, for a Plenary Indulgence. This gives you two distinct forms of grace which offer complete forgiveness. The Plenary Indulgence can be given to someone who died that you wish to pray for.

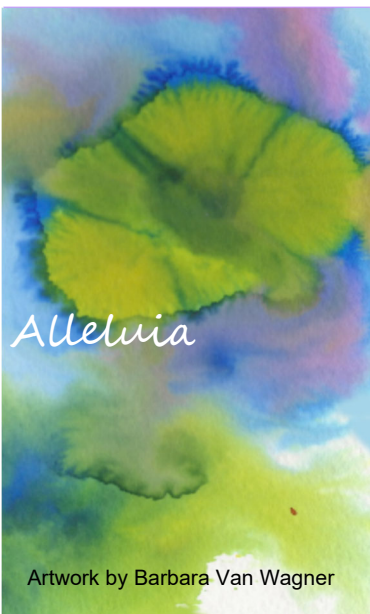
