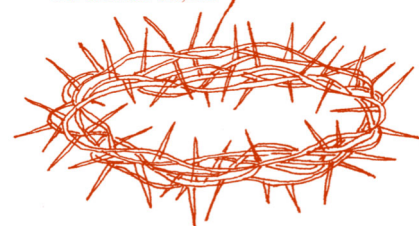

EMMAUS AND THE MASS

The journey to Emmaus is one of the most beloved stories about Jesus. Like so much of life, this story is about the journey, not the destination. Running away from Jerusalem and their fears, probably going home in disillusionment, two of Jesus' disciples encounter Jesus on the road, "but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him" (Luke 24:16). They knew that Jesus had died and they had heard that Jesus' body was missing from the tomb. They were amazed at how Jesus explained the scriptures, giving them a complete rationale for everything Jesus did, Even predicting Jesus' suffering and death.

Later, sharing a meal with him, they recognize the stranger as Jesus, Note how the two travelers reverse course, or "make a U turn" as we might put it? With a certain spring in their steps they went right back to the huddled disciples to make their report. -a 14 mile roundtrip journey! They were bursting with newfound faith and revived hope. Cured of confusion. Pledged to pursue a gospel-focused life.

Like the Mass—we hear the scriptures and an explanation of them, we share a meal, and then we go out to tell the good news. Let us receive Jesus in Communion as often as we can and, with great urgency and excitement, go out and share His love and good news to everyone around us.

**First Reading** — God has raised the crucified Jesus, who now pours forth the Holy Spirit upon us (Acts 2:14, 22-33).

**Psalm** — Our God shows us the way to live (Psalm 16); **Second Reading** - Our faith and hope are in God who raised Jesus from the dead (1 Peter 1:17-21); **Gospel** - Through his words and in the breaking of the bread, the risen Christ made himself known to two disciples on their way to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35).

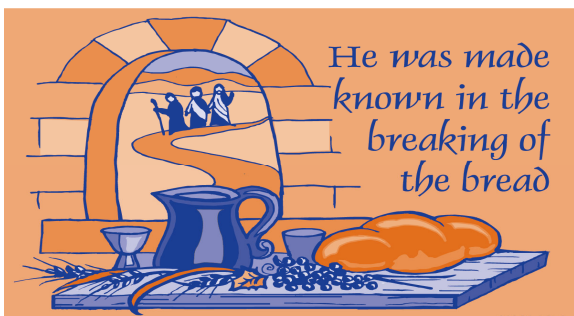
