

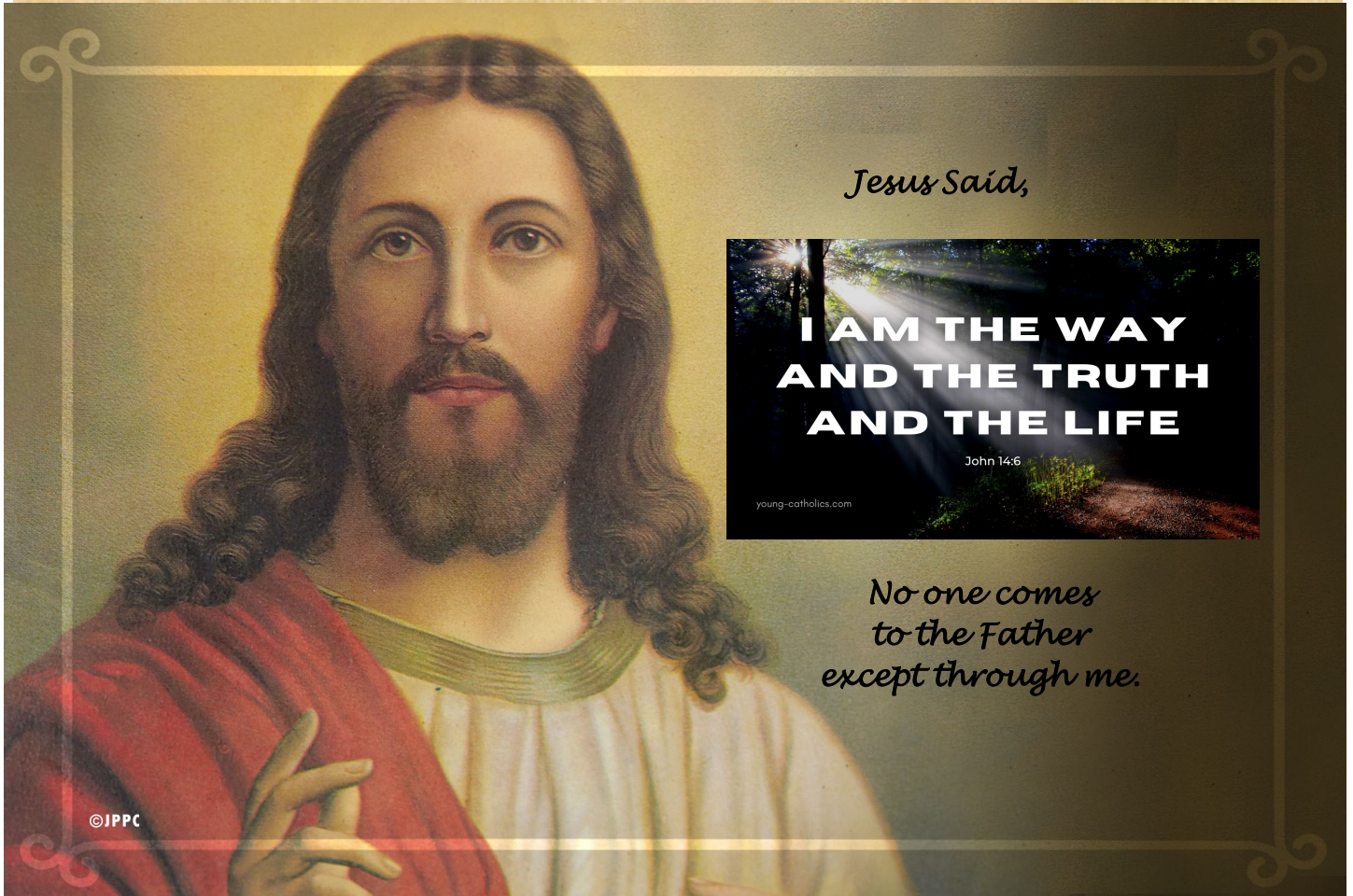

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Acts 6:1-7: the theme of service is prominent as the apostles seek to meet the needs of the community by appointing seven men to serve as deacons. This helps to maintain unity and prevent division within the early church. It also highlights the importance of recognizing and affirming one's vocational calling, as well as the value of vocations within the Church.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 33: Lord let your mercy be on us as we place our trust in you. A prayer of praise and trust in God's mercy.

Second Reading – 1 Peter 2:4-9: Jesus is the cornerstone of the Church and Christians are a chosen and royal priesthood. Believers should come to Christ, who is a living stone, and to offer spiritual sacrifices to God through Him

Gospel – John 14:1-12: Jesus teaches His disciples, assuring them that He will prepare a place for them in His Father's house and declaring Himself as the way, the truth, and the life. He also tells them that those who believe in Him will do greater works than He has done, and promises to send them the Holy Spirit to guide them.

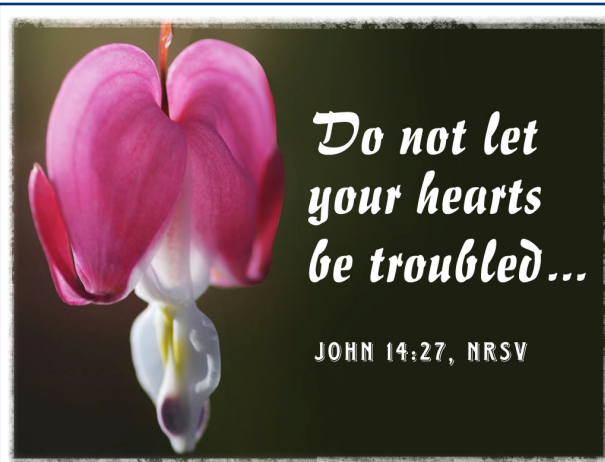

The gospel for the 5th Sunday of Easter Year A offers comfort, guidance, and encouragement to us. This passage is part of Jesus' farewell discourse to his disciples before his crucifixion, and it contains some of the most beautiful and profound words that Jesus ever spoke.

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me." No matter what challenges we may face in life, we can always find peace and comfort in our faith. We are called to trust in God and in Jesus, and to hold fast to that trust no matter what happens.

"In my Father's house there are many dwelling places." Our ultimate home is with God in heaven. We are called to strive for this heavenly home, to live our lives in a way that will allow us to be with God forever.

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." Jesus is the path that we must follow if we want to be close to God. He is the truth that we must seek, and the life that we must live if we want to experience the fullness of God's love.

"Whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these." We are called to continue Jesus' work in the world. We are called to love others, to serve others, and to bring God's light into the darkness of the world.



On this day of your First Holy Communion, may the peace of God be with you and the joy of the Lord fill your heart. You are now united with Jesus, and we pray that you grow closer to Him every day.

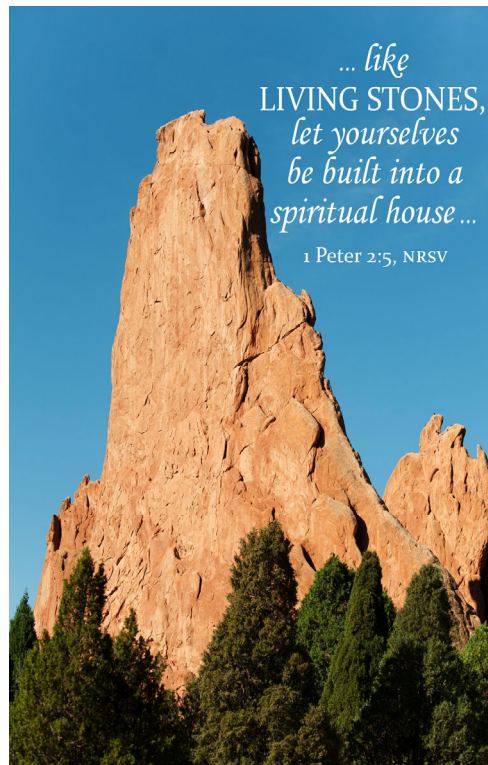
