TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading— [Isaiah 55:10-11](#): The Lord's word is likened to rain that nourishes the earth, promising that it will accomplish its intended purpose without returning void.

Responsorial Psalm —[Psalm 65](#): *The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest.* The land's fruitful yield is a result of divine intervention, leading to joy and celebration.

Second Reading – [Romans 8:18-23](#): Current sufferings are minimal compared to the future glory awaiting God's children.

Gospel – [Matthew 13:1-23](#): Jesus shares a parable about a sower who scattered seeds, symbolizing the spreading of God's word. The seeds fell on different types of soil, representing various responses to the message.

"But as for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty."

Matthew 13:23

By doing so, we create fertile ground for God's Word to take root, grow, and bear fruit in our lives.


