STEP OUT OF THE BOAT

How do we find God in the storms and struggles of our lives, in the trials we encounter in trying to do His will? Even Peter is too overcome by fear to imitate his Lord. His fears, Jesus tells him, are a sign of his lack of faith. And so it often is with us. Our fears make us doubt, make it hard to see His glory dwelling in our midst. Yet, we should know, as we sing in today's Psalm, that His salvation is near to those who hope in Him. By faith we should know, as Paul asserts in today's Epistle, that we are heirs to the promises made to His children, Israel.

*We must trust that He whispers to us in the trials of our lives—that He who has called us to walk along the way of His steps. He will save us whenever we begin to sink. **Courage!***

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading— [1 Kings 19:9A, 11-13A](#): The usual ways of the Lord's presence—wind, earthquake, and fire—are absent here, replaced by a “tiny whispering sound.” When Elijah heard this, he hid his face in his cloak and went and stood at the entrance of the cave. **Responsorial Psalm** — [Psalm 85](#): □ *Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation.* □ **Second Reading** — [Romans 9:1-5](#): “I speak the truth in Christ, I do not lie; my conscience joins with the Holy Spirit in bearing me witness. Paul wishes to harmonize the relationship between his people (the Jews) with the new way of salvation, i.e. in and through Christ. **Gospel** — [Matthew 14:22-33](#): “During the fourth watch of the night, he came toward them walking on the sea. When the disciples saw him walking on the sea they were terrified.”

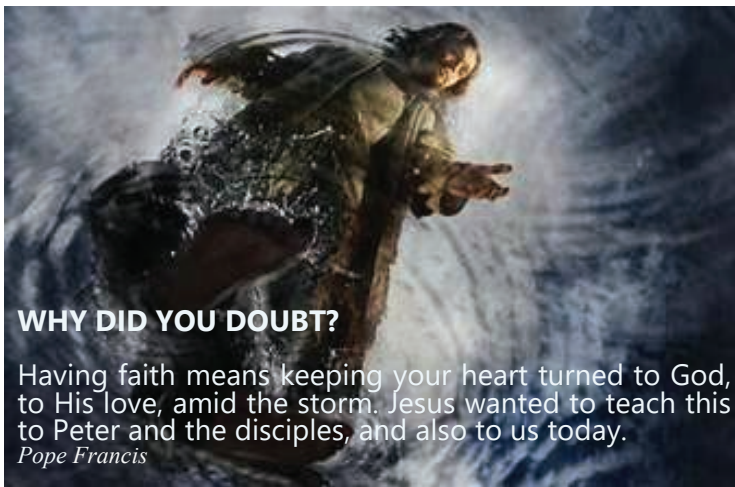
