

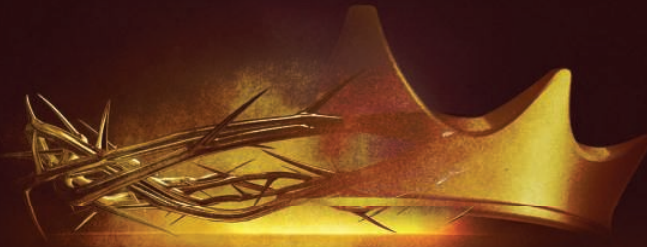

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - [Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17](#): The Lord God promises to act as a shepherd to his scattered flock. He will rescue, pasture, and give them rest. He'll seek the lost, return the strayed, heal the sick, and bind the injured. He will also judge between the different kinds of sheep in his flock.

Responsorial Psalm - [Psalm 23](#): *R. The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.* The LORD is my shepherd who meets all my needs, guiding and sustaining me. I will dwell in his house forever, surrounded by his goodness and kindness.

Second Reading - [1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28](#): Christ has risen, initiating the resurrection for all. He'll reign until all enemies, including death, are defeated. Ultimately, everything will be subjected to God.

Gospel - [Matthew 25:31-46](#): Jesus tells his disciples about the final judgment where people will be separated like sheep and goats. Those who helped the needy will inherit eternal life, being told that their good deeds were done unto Jesus himself. Those who neglected the needy will face eternal punishment.

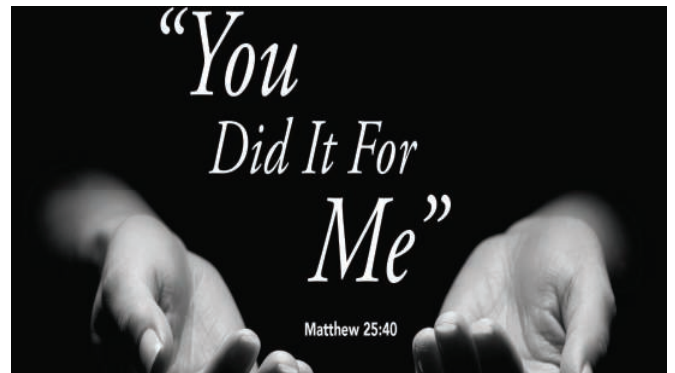

Matt 23:31-46

When did we see You Hungry Lord?

The Church year ends today with a vision of the end of time. The scene in the Gospel is stark and resounds with Old Testament echoes.

The Son of Man is enthroned over all nations and peoples of every language. The nations have been gathered to see His glory and receive His judgment. The King is the divine shepherd Ezekiel, judging as a shepherd separates sheep from goats. Each of us will be judged upon our performance of the simple works of mercy we hear in the Gospel today.

These works, as Jesus explains today, are reflections or measures of our love for Him, our faithfulness to His commandment that we love God with all our might and our neighbor as ourselves.

Our faith is dead, lifeless, unless it be expressed in works of love. And we cannot say we truly love God, whom we cannot see, if we don't love our neighbor, whom we can.

The Lord is our shepherd. And we are to follow His lead, to imitate His exam-

ple. Following Christ, our Shepherd King, means more than just adhering to rules; it means living a life of service. When we assist those who are struggling, we are serving Christ Himself. Thus, caring for the needs of others isn't just a good deed—it is a direct response to the teachings of Jesus, our King.

Let us strive to be following Him in right paths, that this kingdom might be our inheritance, that we might enter into the eternal rest promised for the people of God
