

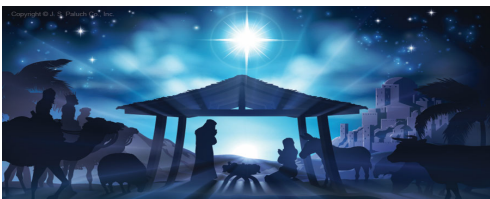


## OUR FASCINATING FAITH
