Indulgenced Acts to obtain a Plenary Indulgence for Holy Souls:

- From November 1 to 8: visit a cemetery and say a mental prayer such as...**
'Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.'
- On November 2: alternatively, you may visit a church and say one Our Father and one Creed**



In addition, you must always satisfy these three general conditions for any Plenary Indulgence (twenty days before or after the indulgenced act):



A Plenary Indulgence for a particular Holy Soul can be earned every day from November 1-8 by repeating all the steps for each day (but we only need to go to Confession once).

Saint John Paul II wrote:

“Above all, the common outcry, which is justly made on behalf of human rights—for example, the right to health, to home, to work, to family, to culture—is false and illusory if **the right to life, the most basic and fundamental right and the condition for all other personal rights**, is not defended with maximum determination.”

(1988, Christifideles Laici, n. 38).

PRAYER BEFORE VOTING

Lord, awaken your people to know that they are not called to be a sect fleeing the world, but rather a community of faith renewing the world. Awaken them that the same hands lifted up to you in prayer are the hands that pull the lever in the voting booth: that the same eyes that read your Word are the eyes that read the names on the ballot, and that they do not cease to be

***Christians when they enter the voting booth.** Awaken your people to a commitment to justice, to the sanctity of marriage and the family, to the dignity of each individual human life, and to the truth that human rights begin when human lives begin, and not one moment later. AMEN*
