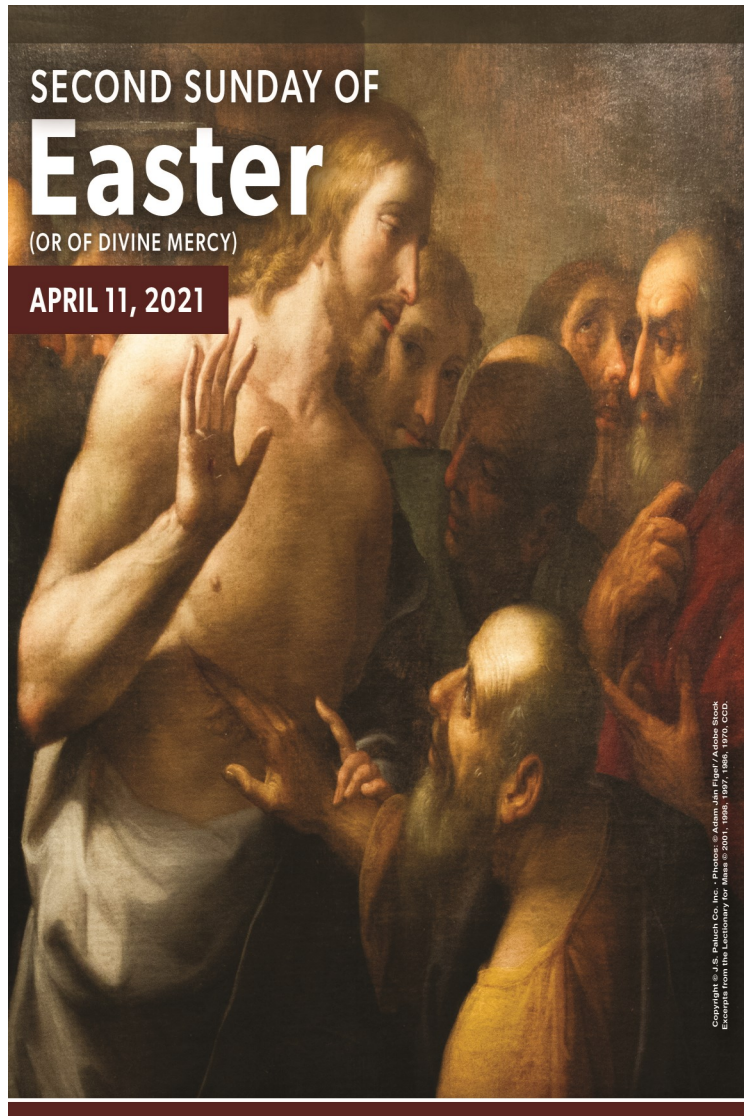

On Divine Mercy Sunday:

vessel only, and that is - trust. The more a soul
